The unclued lights (six of two words and one of three words), one pair or individually, are of a kind, verifiable in *Brewer*. Ignore one apostrophe.

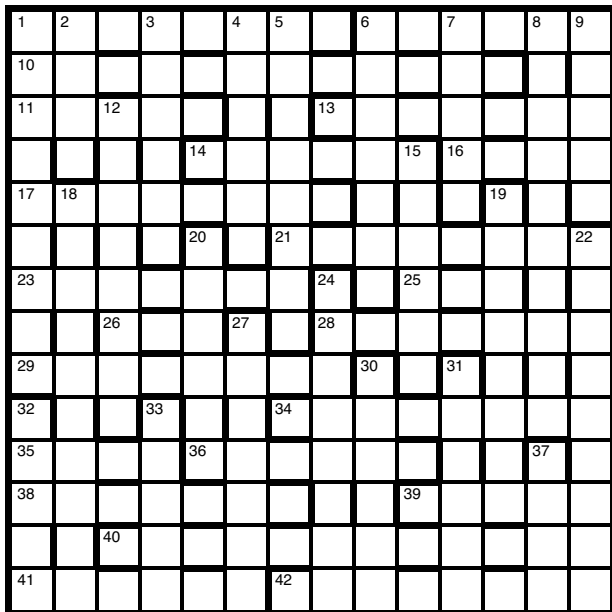
