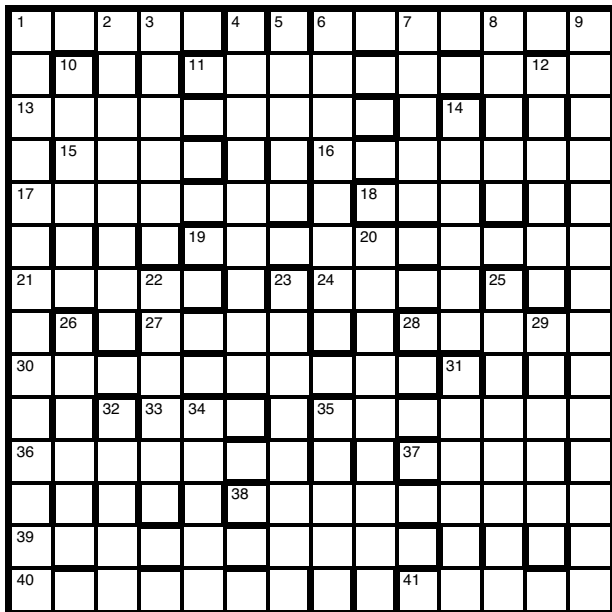
The unclued lights, which include one of four words, one of three words, two of two words, comprise a quotation in *ODQ*. Elsewhere, ignore one apostrophe.
